Date: Thursday 23 June 05, 9.30 – 3.30, \$10 per person.

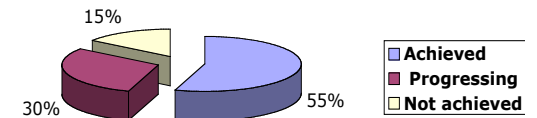
